



Club Policies

Guest Policy:

Elite Advantage Club members have first priority to sign up for trips and can bring one guest per club member on our day trips and overnight trips. Any guests other than a seatmate or roommate will be based on space availability. Club membership can help you secure your spot.

Payment Policy:

Payment for trips may be made by check payable to Hawthorn Bank, cash, or by debiting a Hawthorn Bank checking, savings, or money market account. Payment may be mailed to the attention of Elite Advantage to Hawthorn Bank, P.O. Box 688, 132 E. High St., Jefferson City, MO, 65102. Payment may also be made by coming to the Elite Advantage office at 800 Eastland Drive in Jefferson City, or at any Hawthorn Bank branch.

Refund Policy:

Full refunds or partial refunds will be made when possible. Prepaid tickets, prepaid admissions, and other nonrecoverable costs are non-refundable. However, if a cancelled spot can be filled from a wait list, then a full refund will be given.

Wait List:

WAIT LISTS ARE IMPORTANT!

Unexpected cancellations can occur, so I often draw from a wait list to fill trips. Should a trip fill up, please do not hesitate to get on the wait list. An effort will be made to contact those on the wait list. However, sometimes there is more urgency to fill a spot, and in that case, I will send out a group email and fill vacancies on a first come, first served basis if I have not heard from a wait list contact within a reasonable amount of time.

Inclement Weather:

Please note, if school is cancelled due to inclement weather, so is the Elite Advantage Club event.

Early Sign-Ups:

It is never too early to sign up! If you are considering a trip, please sign up earlier

rather than later to secure your spot. Also, out of courtesy, if you have signed up and find that you are unable to go, please cancel your reservation as soon as possible to free up spots for other customers.

Trip Departure Location:

Jefferson City Day trips depart from the Sam's Club parking lot at 849 Stoneridge Parkway. Pick up will be at the part of the lot nearest the roundabout. When possible, passengers may be picked up at spots in other communities. Pick up and departure locations are subject to change. The trip departure location for overnight trips is from 3600 Amazonas Drive.
